



What will I study?

The Single Award is made up of the two Units:

- **Unit 1:** 911 Health and Social Care and Early Year Provision. Including:
 - The roles and skills of people working in health, social care and early years
 - Studying the needs of major client groups
 - The principles of care work
- **Unit 2:** 912 Understanding Personal Development and Relationships
 - Stages and pattern of human growth and development and what factors affect this
 - The development of self-concept and different types of relationships

The course provides you with an introduction to the Health and Social Care sector and some of the skills needed in the workplace or for progression to further education.

How will I be assessed?

Controlled Assessment **60%**

Written Examination **40%**

For the controlled assessment, you will choose one of the following services; Health / Social Care / Early Years Provision, and then select a profession from it to study.

What advanced courses can this subject lead on to?

- A LEVEL Health and Social Care, Psychology and Sociology
- BTEC, Children's Play, Learning and Development equivalent of 3 A Levels and BTEC National Diploma in Health and Social Care
- BTEC, Health and Social Care, equivalent of 1 A level

What might this subject lead you on to after leaving school?

- Degree or Diploma in Nursing, Radiography, Health Studies Education, Occupational Therapy.
- This subject could also lead to careers such as: Nursing, Teaching, Occupational Therapy, Radiography, Social Work, the Caring Profession, Physiotherapy, Psychology, and Childhood Studies.
